

• A Professional Board (PB)

Our 58 sections represent members from the same geographical sector (school board, school services centers or region). The sections role is to recruit, inform and offer a support network to members. Members elect the section council, which represents them in discussions with the general secretariat of school boards in collaboration with the labour relations service of the AQCS. The section council is also responsible for organizing activities to ensure a rich and dynamic association life.
